## FCC RESCHEDULES LPTV/TRANSLATOR WEBINAR FOR FEBRUARY 24 AND ANNOUNCES MARCH DATES AND LOCATIONS FOR SPECTRUM AUCTION INFORMATION SESSIONS

The FCC has announced the information for several informational sessions relating to the incentive auction.

First, in a <u>Public Notice</u>, the FCC has provided dates and locations for "information sessions" scheduled for March 2015 that are intended "to provide broadcasters with the opportunity to learn more about the auction." The schedule for these information sessions in March is set forth below. (According to the FCC, the schedule for future visits will be announced in additional public notices.)

## March Broadcaster Information Session Locations and Dates

- March 9, 2015: Buffalo, NY
- March 10, 2015: Detroit, MI, and Lansing, MI (in Lansing, MI)
- March 16, 2015: Raleigh-Durham, NC
- March 17, 2015: Charlotte, NC

According to the Public Notice, members of the FCC's Incentive Auction Task Force will hold a general session about the auction and repacking process and will also be available to meet with individual broadcasters on a confidential basis. The FCC is encouraging broadcasters in markets where visits have not been scheduled to attend the session that is closest to their respective market. *Second*, in another <u>Public Notice</u>, the FCC announced that it has rescheduled the LPTV/TV Translator Incentive Auction webinar for Tuesday, February 24 at 2:00 p.m. (ET). As

previously announced, this webinar is intended to "facilitate public input and understanding of issues relating to the impact of the incentive auction and repacking on LPTV and TV translator stations." Here is how broadcasters can participate in the February 24 webinar:
